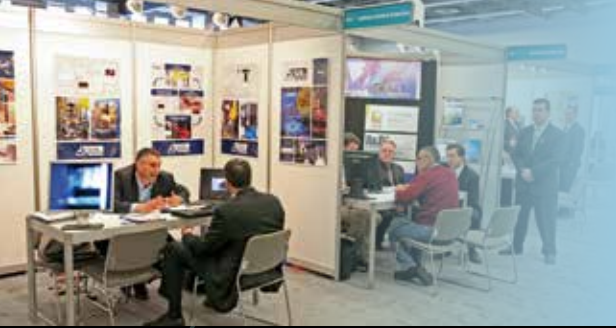
- **Bell Helicopter Textron Canada:** a leading company in design and production of commercial helicopters, as well as after sales support.
